



Q3 Does any other member of your household use Belleville Public Library services?





Q4 Regardless whether you are a library user or not, how important do you feel having a Public Library is to the quality of life in our Belleville community?



Q13 Have you ever read an electronic book (e-book) on a tablet, computer, smartphone, or e-reader (Kindle, Nook)?



Q14 Prior to taking this survey, have you visited the Library's Internet website www.bellevillelibrary-wi.org during the past year?




Q19 If the library hours were to change, what new hours are important to you personally (that you would be likely to use)?






Q21 Are there children living in your home? Please check all that apply.






