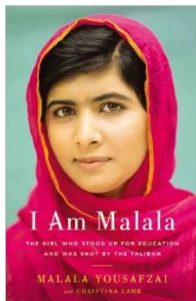

## LinkCat Tips & Tricks

**What is My P.I.N?** Your PIN is simply your birthdate: But only 4 digits – 2 for the month and 2 for the day – no year. For example, if your birthdate is Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup>, your PIN is 0903.

You need your **PIN** along with your **library barcode number** to log on to the library's computers, place holds, use Overdrive, and manage your account online.

Once logged in to your account, you can check on due dates, renew items, and suspend holds.

**Suspending Holds** puts you in control. If you don't want to receive 20 DVDs at once, or if you want to make sure to receive a series in order, simply place holds on all the titles, then suspend all but the titles you want to be sent first. You'll move up through the queue, but your hold won't be filled until you un-suspend the hold.
